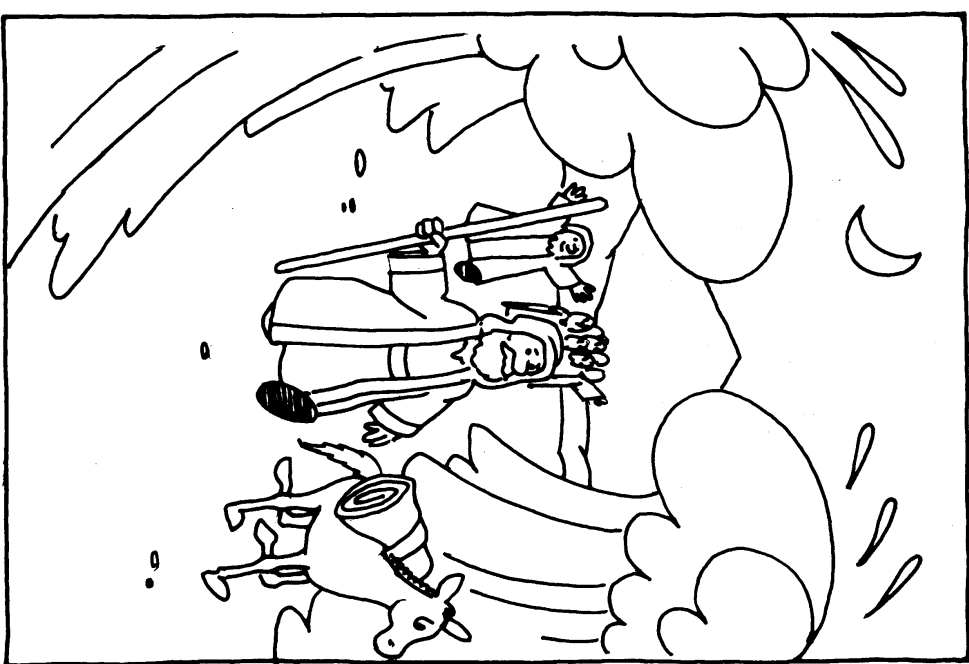
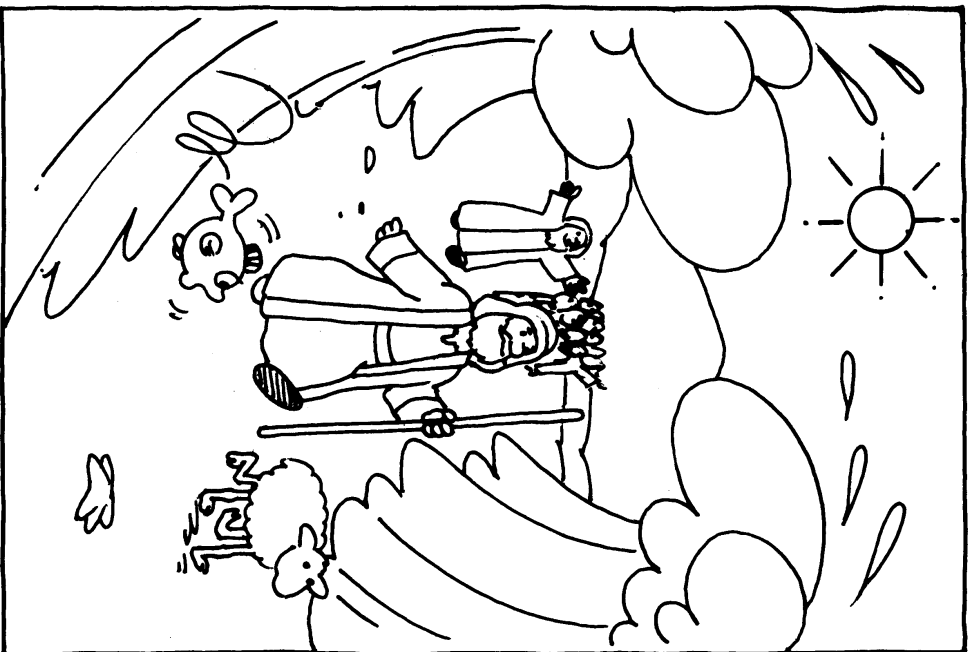

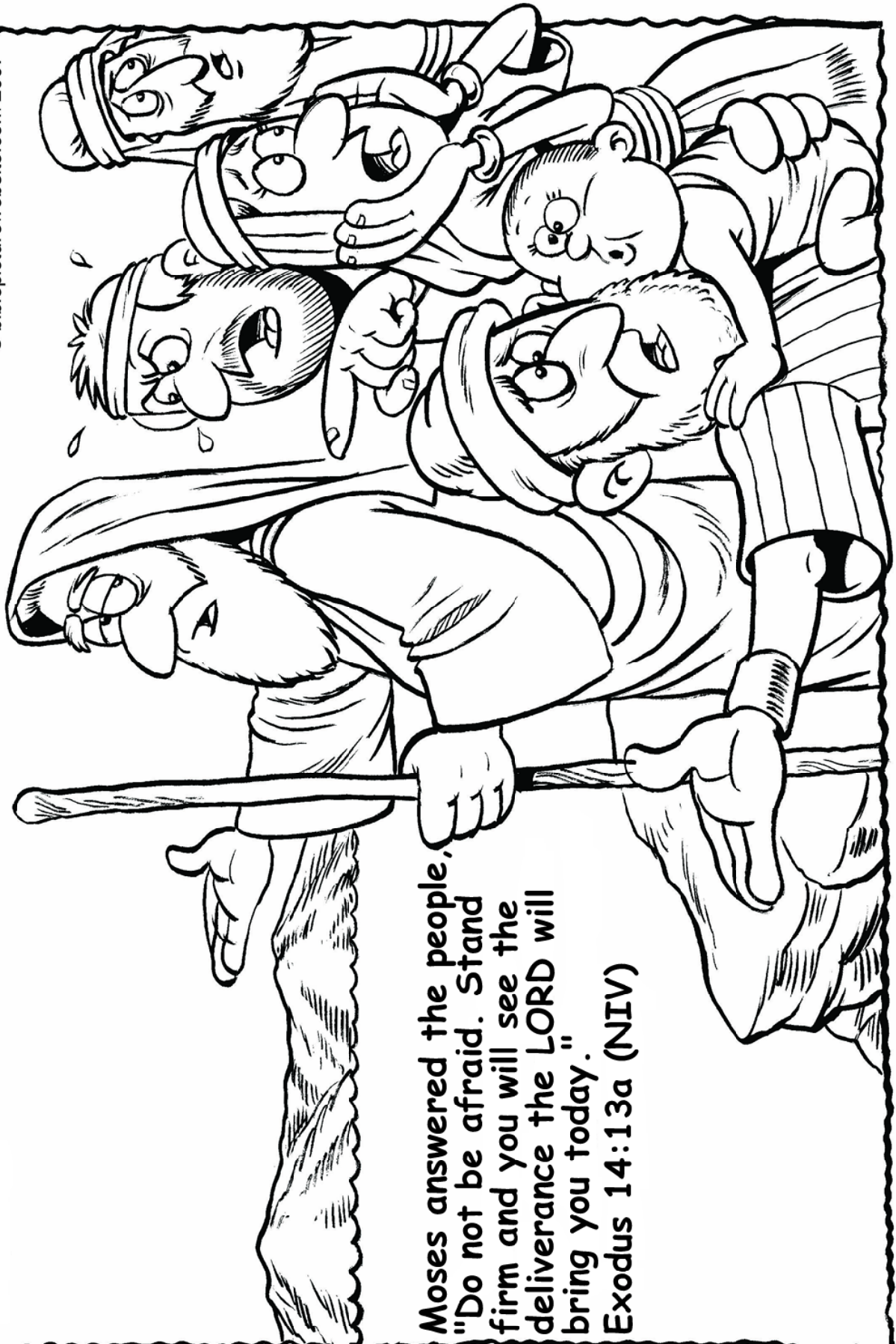

Look at these two pictures of the Israelites crossing the Red Sea. Circle five things that are different in the second picture.



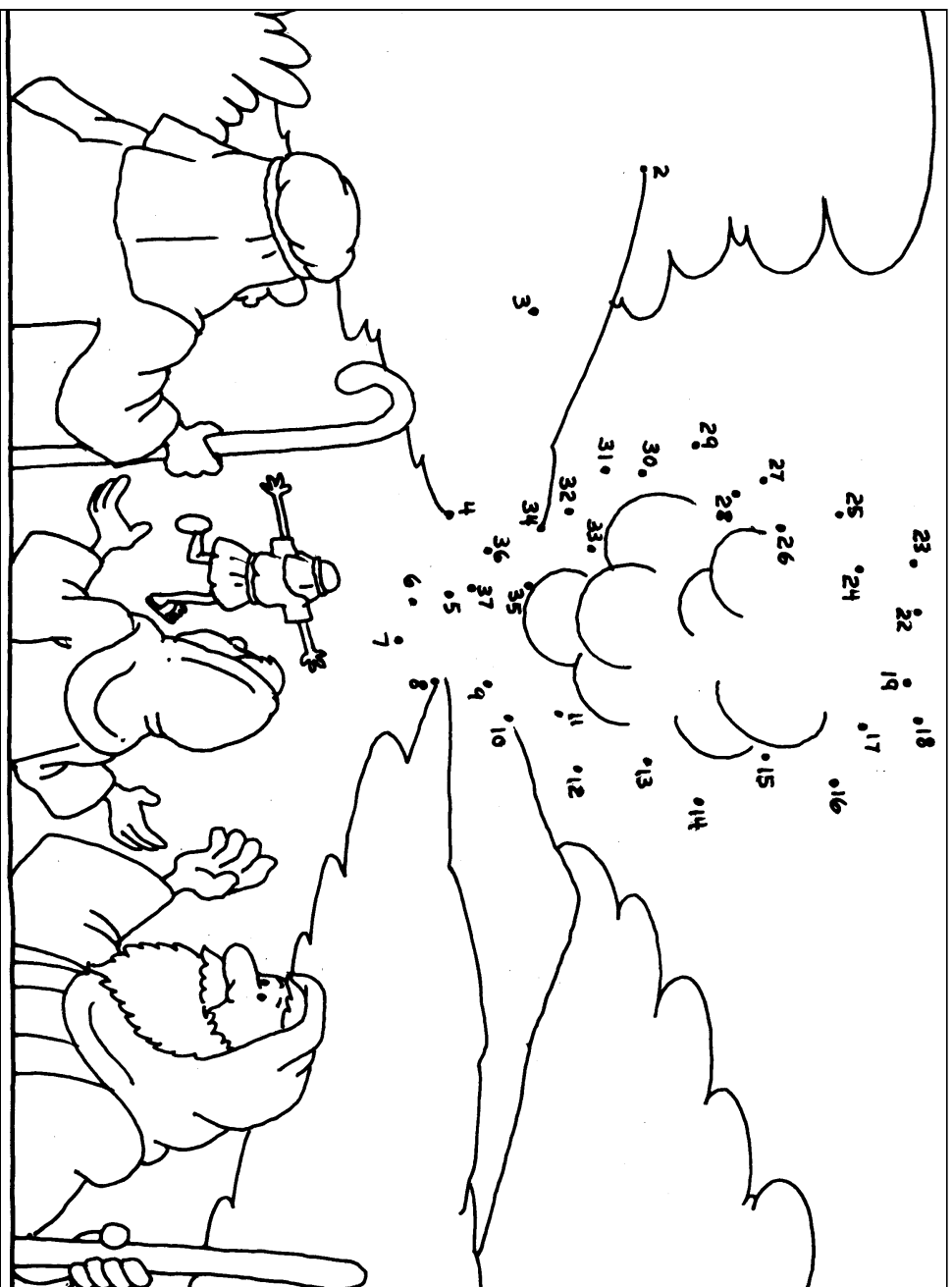

Starting with #1, connect the dots to see how God led the Israelites to freedom.

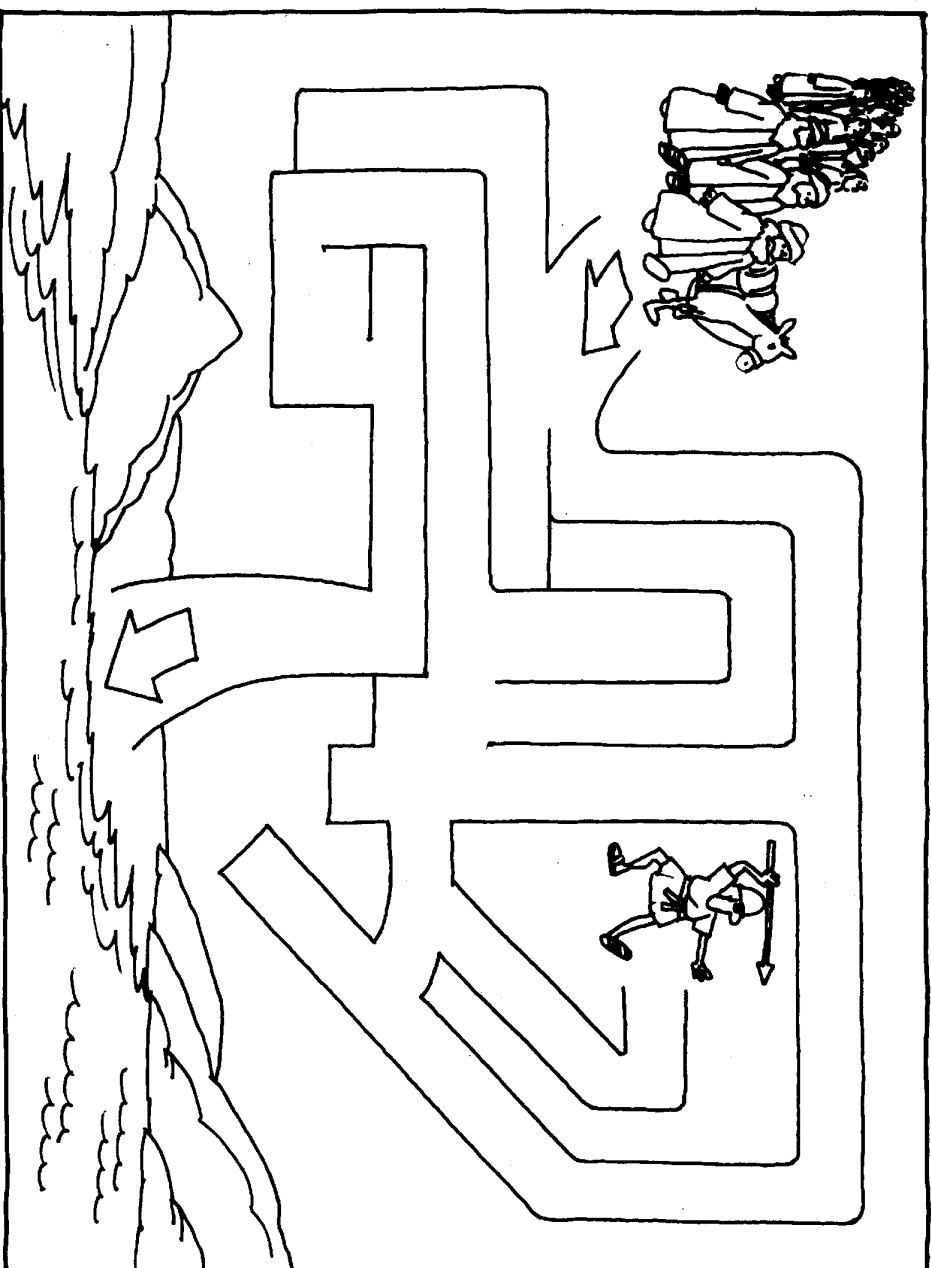
