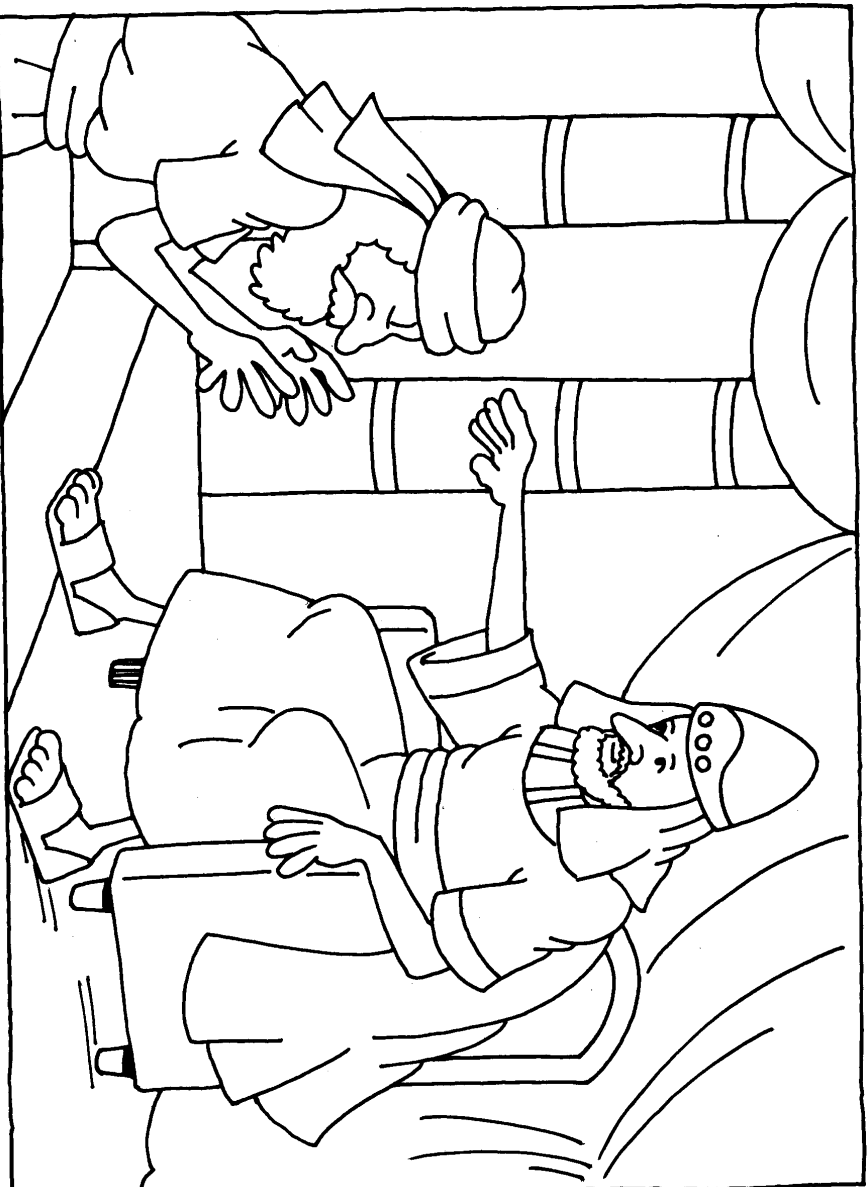

Color this picture.

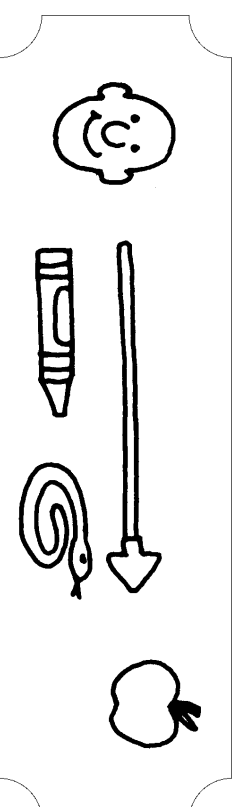
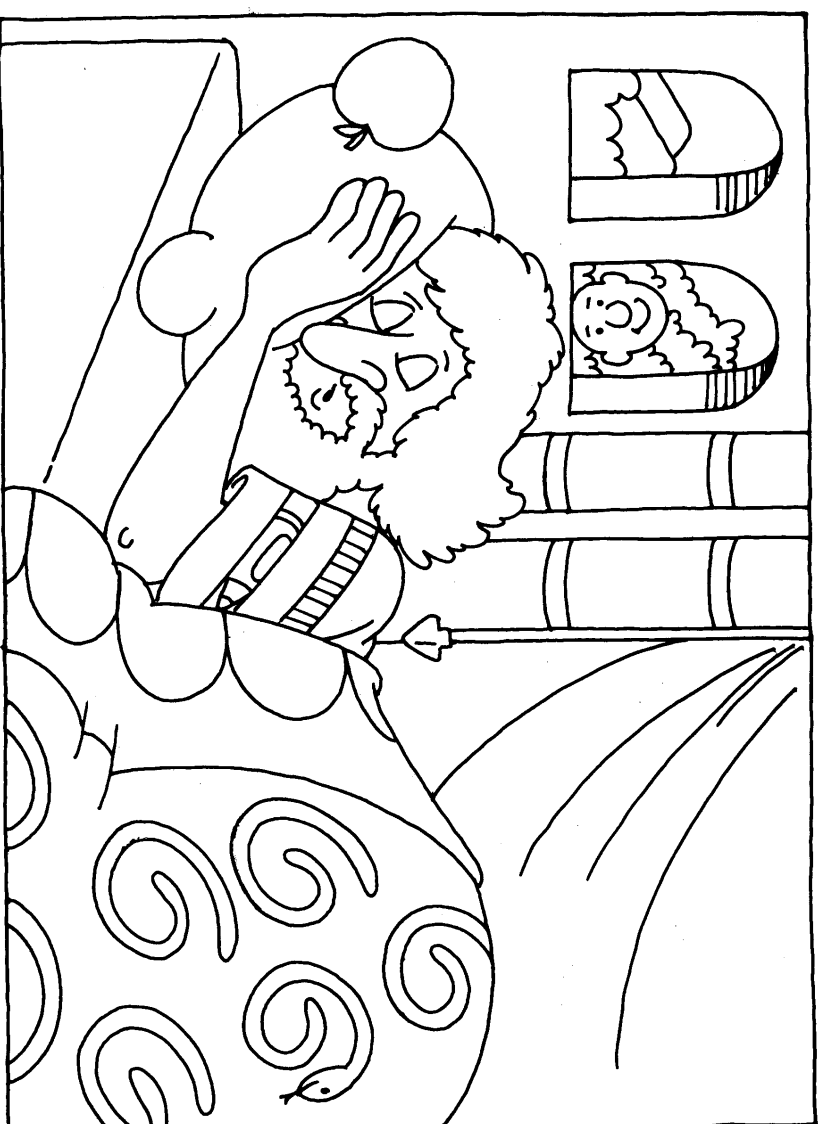


King David grew old and soon his life ended. His son, Solomon became the new king of Israel.

# Solomon's Wise Choice

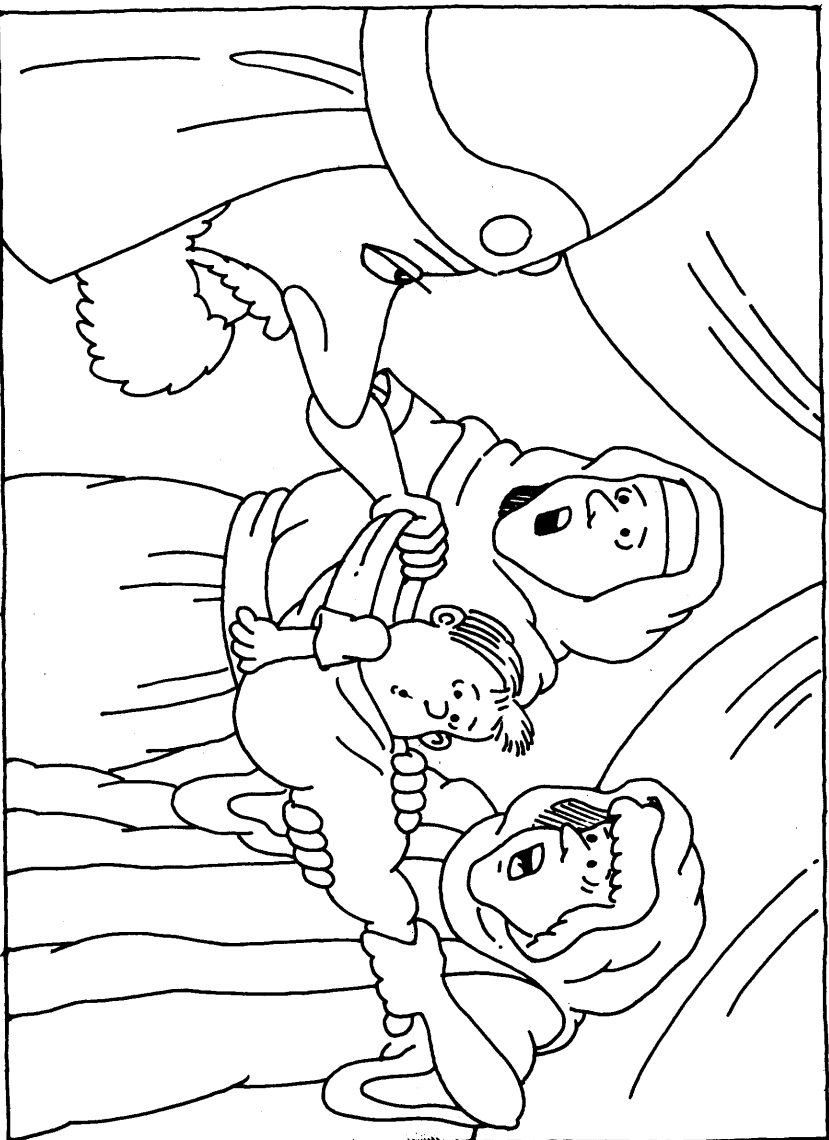
Look for the items shown in the box in the picture. Circle them.

# The Queen of Sheba

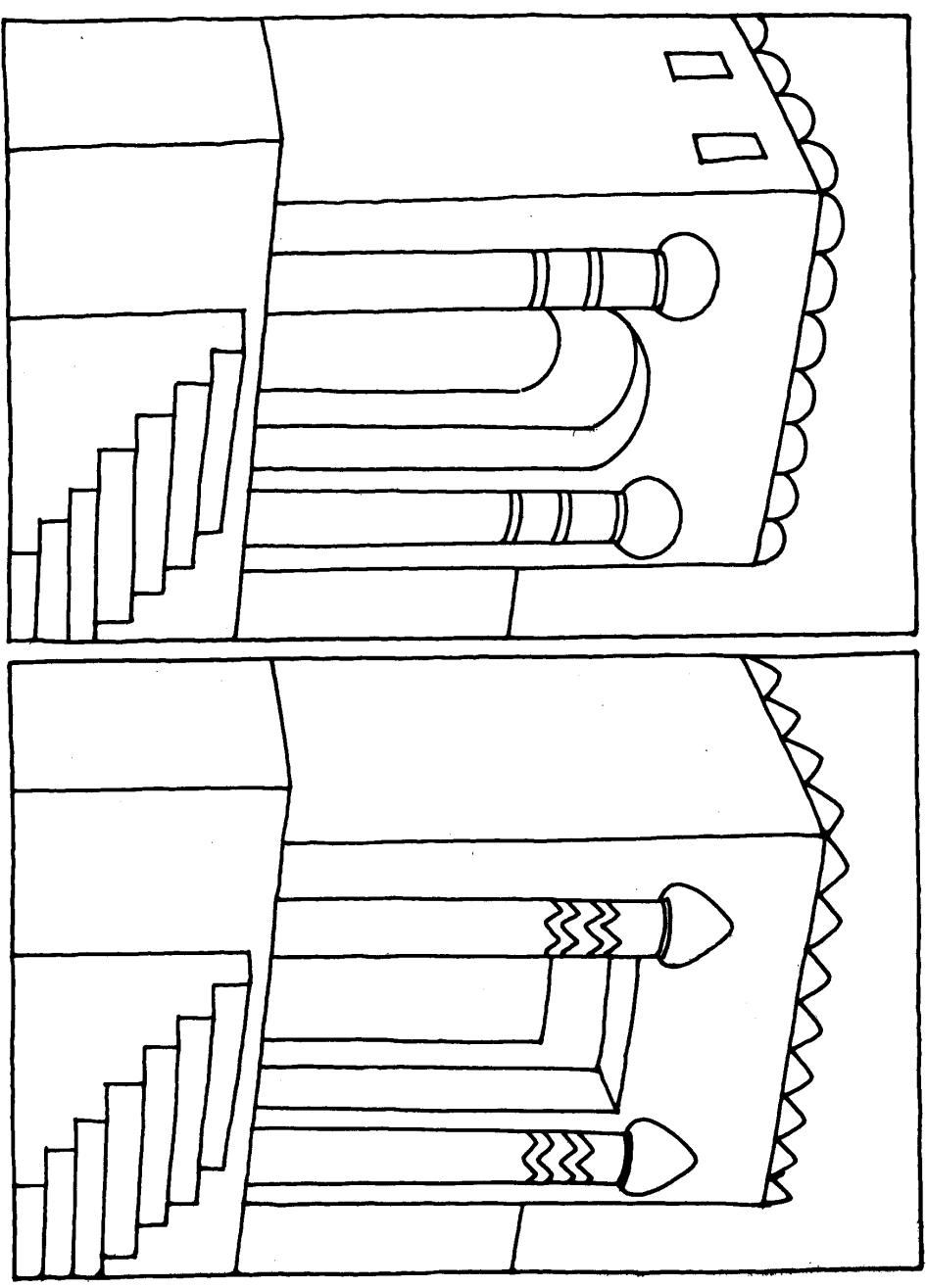

# God's Temple Is Built

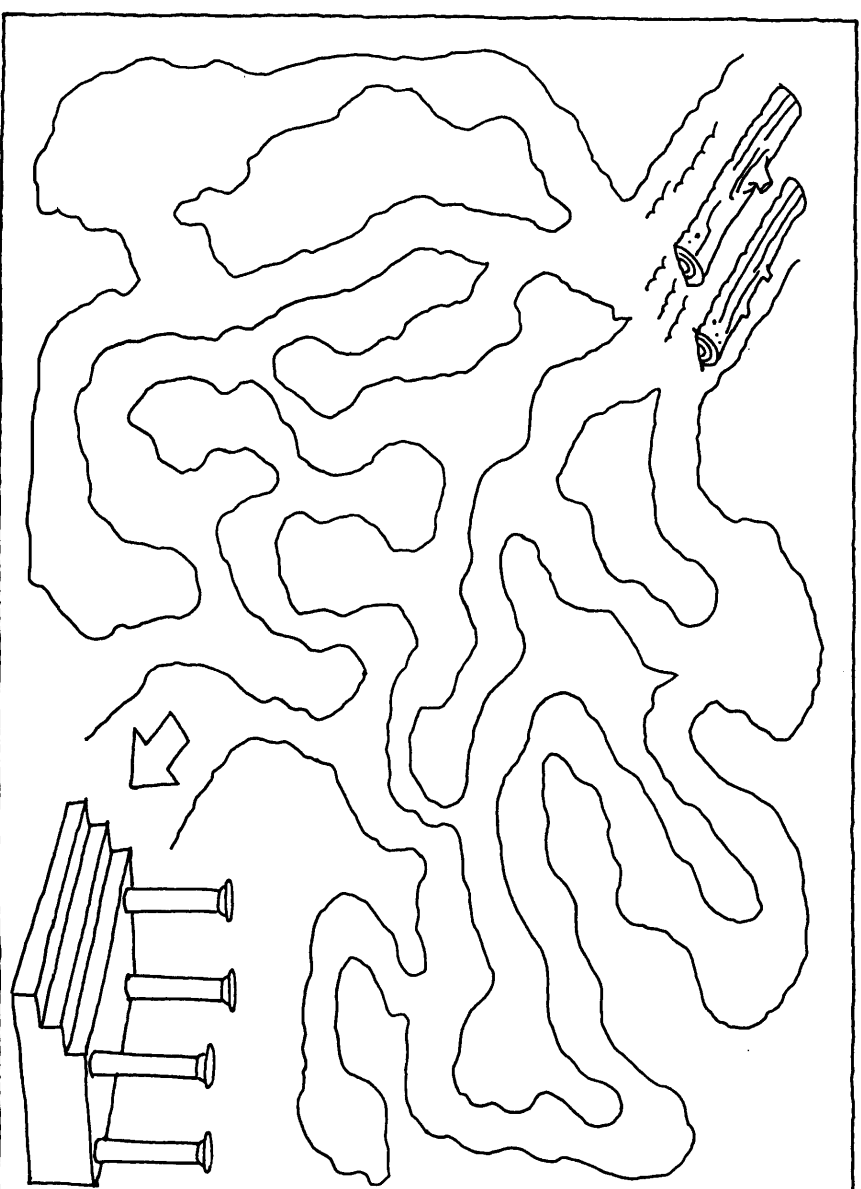
Look at these two pictures. There are 5 things different in the second picture. Circle the differences.

# Temple Materials

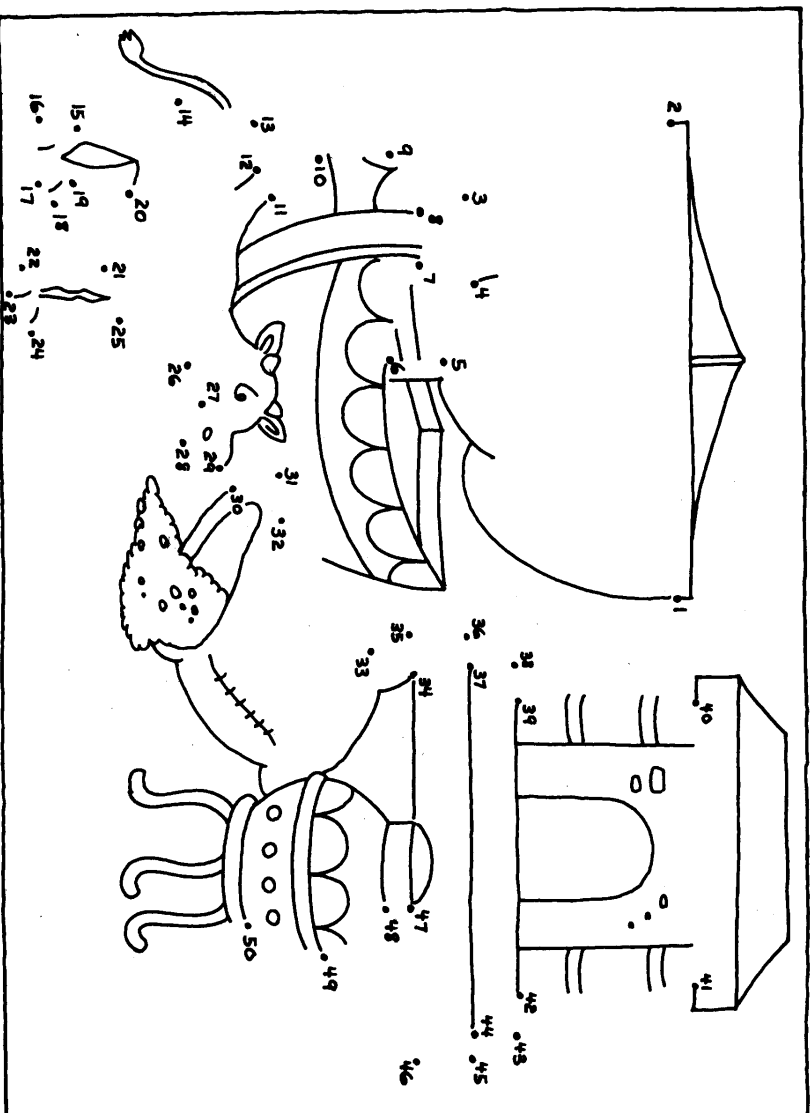
